

## MARCH 13, 2007

The Harriman City council met in regular session Tuesday March 6th, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Harriman Municipal/Utility Building. The Honorable Jerry Davis Mayor was present and presiding. Mayor called meeting to order. Roll call of Council was as follows:

Mayor Davis asked for a motion to approve the minutes from 03/06. Councilmember Gallaher made the motion and Councilmember Tedder seconded the motion. The motion passed with a unanimous "Aye".

Mayor Davis asked for a motion to pay the bills. Councilmember Mason made the motion and was seconded by Councilmember Morris. The motion passed with a unanimous "Aye".

Mayor Davis called to hear delegations.

Mr. Earl King, with Keep Roane Beautiful, asked council if they would help with a clean up on Saturday March 31<sup>st</sup>. He stated that this would be a county- wide project. Mayor Davis stated that he and the council would do what they could to help.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**HOME GRANT**-Bob Tidwell stated that he had sent out three letters for bid on the 2007 Home Grant program and only received one from Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Campbell. Mayor Davis opened the bid but could not find a dollar amount. Charles Kerley explained that since it is from an engineering firm that it was not necessarily a bid but a summary of services. The motion was made, contingent on the total price, by Councilmember Mason and seconded by Councilmember Tedder. The motion passed with a unanimous "Aye".

**HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS**-Councilmember Mason stated that he had talked with the property owners of the roadway to the Holiday Inn Express about the city purchasing this property. He stated that they were on vacation and when they returned he would schedule a meeting for further discussion.

**STREET LIGHTS**-Councilmember Mason stated that the street light on the corner of Clinton and Morgan has not been put back up yet. Councilmember Morris stated that he had talked with Steve Ladd with the Harriman Utility Board and they are in the process of putting up the streetlights that were taken down for paving on Morgan Street.

**MR. KIRKLAND**-Councilmember Sampson stated that Mr. Kirkland was putting his junk on city property again and asked if the building inspector could have him cited to court. Mayor Davis stated he would look into it.


