
FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 07-05-01-Tracey Bolden read the first reading of an ordinance adopting pursuant to sections 13-7-201 through 13-7-210 of the Tennessee Code Annotated for the purpose of amending the Harriman, Tennessee municipal zoning ordinance, appendix D, F-1 Flood Hazard District Regulations, regulating the floodplain areas of Harriman, Tennessee. The motion was made by Councilmember Tedder and seconded by Councilmember Mason. The vote passed with a unanimous "Aye".

RECREATION PARK-Mayor Davis stated that Bob Tidwell had been working with Harriman Utility Board and Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Canon on checking on some different areas for a recreation complex. Mr. Tidwell stated that he would be setting up a meeting regarding these findings.
