

**SPECIAL CALL
APRIL 20, 2010**

The Harriman City council met in a special call session April 20, 2010 at 6:00 P.M. in the City Municipal Complex. Mayor Mason was present and presiding. Mayor Mason called meeting to order. Roll call of Council was as follows:

Discuss and possibly take action on the Golf Cart Lease for the Emory Golf Course
Mayor Mason reported the golf cart five year lease runs out next year. Yamaha has given the Golf Course an opportunity to resign a new five year lease and receive new golf carts. The lease amount will stay the same and they will bill us seven months out of the year. This will help for the slow time in the winter. Councilmember Wright asked why the council is even acting on this. Mayor Mason and Dr. Kerley stated the council has to approve all contracts. Councilmember Wright asked if the City would be paying for the golf carts. Dr. Kerley stated they would be paid from the Golf Course budget. If the Golf Course doesn't bring in enough revenue then we have to fund things another way.

Councilmember Mynatt arrived at 6:07p.m.

Dr. Kerley stated what you are essentially doing is adding four years to the lease. Mayor Mason asked for a motion to move forward with signing the five year golf cart lease with Yamaha. Councilmember Sampson made the motion and this was seconded by Councilmember Holley. Councilmember Holley believed this would be a good deal. After much discussion the motion passed with a unanimous roll call "Yes".

Mayor Mason reported no other business can be discussed at a Special Call so the meeting was adjourned.
